SHOW INFORMATION- PLEASE READ

Heart House Mission: If you are new to our company, welcome! Similar to most theatrical companies our mission is to strive for high quality productions for the audience and performers. Where we differ is our effort to include more and more actors and techs with disabilities and continue the quest for inclusion. **Performers of all abilities are encouraged to audition (with either past or no theatrical experience). One positive interaction can change the world.** All we currently ask is that all participants are able to comply with our Code of Conduct.

Into the Woods style: Our hopes for this show is to create a complete and fantastical living world. The set will be entirely black and white, with vivid props and costumes. The ensemble and various other cast members will use puppets and large prop pieces to make the scenery come to life (think animals, beanstalk, the giant, carriages). For those cast in our ensemble, don't ever feel as though you are receiving a lesser role, you will be kept active on stage for the majority of the show.

Audition Expectations:

- Performers are to arrive 10 minutes prior to their audition slot.
- They should prepare at least 16 bars of any musical theater song that best showcases their range.**
- There will be NO live pianist, so all performers must bring a pre-recorded track (easily found online for most songs) and will be able to play it from a speaker. Our show is done entirely with recorded tracks so this is an excellent chance to show your ability to pick up on non visual musical cues.**

Rehearsal Expectations:

- Rehearsals will be held in the Ferlazzo building utilizing the stage and conference rooms for more direct rehearsals.
- Actors are expected to bring their scripts, water and a snack if needed, and to dress comfortably.

-If an actor is going to be late to rehearsal or has a sudden conflict they need to reach out to the Stage Manager as soon as possible.

Script Expectations:

-Performers will be expected to be off script by June 28.

-Scripts may be marked up via pencil or post-it notes, but no pen. If a book is returned in damaged condition the performer may be asked to pay the \$35 replacement fee.
